

Conviction Integrity Unit

The Office of the District Attorney, Bronx County, is seeking dynamic candidates for the position of Assistant District Attorney within the Conviction Integrity Unit (CIU). The potential candidates should be attorneys with at least 10 years trial experience investigating serious violent felonies.

Although the accuracy of a conviction has always been a part of the District Attorney's mandate, the creation of a sophisticated unit dedicated to improving the quality and integrity of prosecutions throughout the Office is entirely new. CIU intends to be a national leader in the field.

CIU has two important functions. First, CIU reviews post-judgment claims of actual innocence and wrongful conviction in our most serious cases. The review is generally fact-based and extra-judicial. When appropriate, the Bronx CIU thoroughly reinvestigates a case.

Second, CIU works closely with Executive Staff, Trial Division Supervisors, and the Legal Training Unit, and chairs the Best Practices Committee, to help implement and follow best practices in our current prosecution of cases, and to ensure compliance with all legal and ethical obligations.
