The Bureau is responsible for Asset Forfeiture, Evictions, FOIL, Subpoena Compliance and Special Litigation. Through provisional remedies and other means, the Bureau aggressively, yet fairly, pursues the proceeds and instrumentalities of crime in all of its forms, especially money laundering, tax offenses, and sophisticated financial frauds that victimize our community. The Bureau also responds to proper FOIL requests and other legal process, including subpoenas, and otherwise provides litigation support to the Office. Finally, the Bureau institutes Article 78 and other proceedings, as required, to advance the interests of the Office in an appropriate manner.

The **Chief of the Civil Litigation Bureau** must be a person of vision who is seeking a challenge and has experience in all of the aforementioned areas, including temporary restraining orders, preliminary injunctions and orders of attachment. A background in financial investigations is preferred.
