

CHIEF OF THE HOMICIDE BUREAU

The Bronx District Attorney is seeking an experienced attorney (10+ years) with outstanding management experience, investigative skills, and expertise in criminal law to lead the Homicide Bureau. The Bureau is comprised of 15 senior trial attorneys plus support staff.

The Homicide Bureau prosecutes the majority of the homicides committed in the Bronx. The Bureau will be responsible for responding, on a 24-hour on-call basis, to crime scenes, precincts, and other locations to assist the Police Department and other agencies as they investigate these incidents and, eventually, will draft the complaints to support an arrest. The Chief will be expected to be on call to approve charging decisions, assist the attorneys and police as they investigate, and be a liaison to the District Attorney on all cases. The Bureau handles all of its cases vertically, from the arrest to trial.

The ideal candidate for Chief will be someone who has vast trial and investigative experience and is able to multi-task effectively and under pressure.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- working with the NYPD, State and Federal law enforcement agencies at all levels
- education and training of attorneys/support staff on all facets of homicide cases
- conducting case conferences and reviews regularly
- interacting with members of the community and victims' families
- responding to calls and/or scenes on a 24-hour basis
- authorizing plea offers and giving legal advice
