Ambrosi, A. Fabrizio 18 Motions	Darlin Garcia Miguelange Lopez Adell Batista	Charged with second-degree Conspiracy, first-degree Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance, and additional charges. The defendants allegedly operated a Fentanyl mill in the Bronx that supplied traffickers in the metropolitan area.
Milanes, M. Parker 77 Motions	Windella Sanderson Wells	Between September 1, 2019, and May 1, 2023, the defendant allegedly posed as both a licensed attorney and accredited immigration preparer. She allegedly charged exorbitant fees to improve immigration applications which were all rejected. She allegedly defrauded 10 people out of a total of \$73,000. The defendant allegedly targeted people from the Guyanese, Jamaican and Haitian communities.
