ADA Judge Part # Status	Defendant Name	Case Details
Collins, T. Isales 77 Motions	Benjamin Lozovsky	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. On September 8, 2024, the defendant allegedly killed Jacklyn Timinski by hitting her in the head with a kettlebell inside an apartment on Shore Drive.
Kimmelman, J. Morales 96 COC	Enrique Lopez	Charged with two counts of second-degree Manslaughter and additional charges. On January 21, 2024, the defendant allegedly caused the death of two passengers and severely injured a third passenger after his stunt driving resulted in a crash near Viele and Bryant Avenues.

ADA Judge Part # Status	Defendant Name	Case Details
Miras, J. Clancy 28 Conference	Jayden Rivera	Charged with first-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly killed his father, his father's girlfriend, and their 5-year-old son in an apartment in Mott Haven on November 26, 2023.

<b>Sannicandro, R. Steed 71 Motion</b>	<b>Kyshawn Johnson</b>	Charged with Attempted Murder in the second-degree and additional charges. On September 9, 2022, defendant allegedly supplied a gun to a co-defendant who went to the Pelham Parkway Houses and allegedly fired at least 13 times into a crowd. Four innocent bystanders were shot.
<b>Baughman, R. Busching 14 Conference</b>	<b>Papa Diop</b>	Charged with first-degree Rape and additional charges. On August 5, 2024, the defendant allegedly approached a woman near 149th Street and Bergen Avenue and then raped her.
<b>Suminski, G. Clancy 28 Conference</b>	<b>Shaun Pyles</b>	Charged with second-degree Murder and first-degree Manslaughter. The defendant allegedly fatally stabbed Tyquan Person with a knife on March 24, 2023.

<b>ADA Judge Part #</b>	<b>Defendant Name</b>	<b>Case Details</b>
<b>Perez, C. Stone 27 Sentencing</b>	<b>Kenneth Hood</b>	Found guilty of Official Misconduct and second-degree Reckless Endangerment. On December 27, 2019, the defendant, was a correction officer on duty at Rikers Island when detainee Nicholas Feliciano tried to hang himself.
<b>Miras, J. Yearwood TRP Motion</b>	<b>Edison Cruz</b>	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly shot and killed David Scott and wounded two bystanders on May 3, 2022, after a fight inside a Taco Bell on Jerome Avenue.
<b>Commelin, C. Isales 77 COC</b>	<b>Freddy Flores</b>	Charged with Attempted Murder in the second-degree and additional charges. On the afternoon of March 30, 2024, on East Fordham Road, the defendant allegedly fired a gun five times from across the street. A stray bullet struck a 2-year-old boy in the left hip.

<b>Vega, J. Lewis 70 Appearance</b>	<b>Lillibeth Vasquez</b>	Charged with second-degree Murder, and first-degree Manslaughter. The defendant allegedly crashed into Robert Jimenez on November 26, 2023, who was on a scooter, causing his death.
<b>Baughman, R. Stone 27 Appearance</b>	<b>Tajanhae Brown</b>	Charged with Attempted Assault in the first - degree and additional charges. The defendant allegedly caused her young daughter to become ill by giving her an overdose of prescription medication to treat epilepsy.
<b>Militano, A. McCormack 22 Appearance</b>	<b>Navasia Jones Paul Fine Jr.</b>	Charged with two counts of second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant, between August 8, 2021, and August 10, 2021, allegedly acting in concert with her son, took actions leading to the death of her 7-year-old daughter, Julissia Batties.

<b>ADA Judge Part # Status</b>	<b>Defendant Name</b>	<b>Case Details</b>
<b>Ambrosi, A. Isales 77 Sentencing</b>	<b>Dayshawn Bannister</b>	Pleaded guilty to Attempted Murder in the second-degree and additional charges. The defendant stabbed Cheddie Defrietis in the head with a knife on an MTA bus puncturing his brain.
<b>Strout, N. Morales 96 COC</b>	<b>Emmanuel Awah Elias Afflada</b>	Charged with Attempted Murder in the second-degree and additional charges. On January 1, 2024, the defendants acting in concert, allegedly stabbed Carlos Pilliza after he wished them a Happy New Year at the 182nd Street subway station.

<b>Scaccia, C. Fabrizio 18 Hearing/Trial</b>	<b>Gregory Fleetwood</b>	Charged with second-degree Murder. The defendant allegedly strangled a pregnant woman in 1996, leading to her death.
